- Upon first time selection, you will be asked to download the Smart Card app called **Rally CU Smart Card.** Visit your app store to download.
- Once you have installed the app, close out of both the Mobile Banking and Smart Card apps so the information will refresh.
- Log back into the Smart Card app and you're ready to set up card controls and alerts.
